As in a sort of grotesque nightmare, with them we will visit the singing café and the blockhouse, the Bedouin encampment and the military march, the brothels and the precipices, the unbearable thirst, the scorched bodies, severed heads, entrails... of an unnecessary, unjust and cruel war, including the use of toxic gases, in which thousands of Spaniards and Rifians died and which had crucial consequences for the events of the 20th century in Spain."
